1256 - 1203	Valbush	Began the Burggite "War" of extermination. The goal was to remove all traces of Burggites from Vulpash lands. Most Burggite families were killed or changed their names.
1203 - 1178	Vakriyala	Reallowed the use of traditional Burggite names.
1178 - 1151	Valomajjash	Is rumored to have had many affairs with Burggite women.
1151 - 1123	Alkvesh	Is rumored to be a bastard son of Valomajjash and a Burggite prostitute. The prostitute was named Akravada and is said to be a descendent of Aravik of the Aravid Dynasty. Ended the Burggite "War" of Extermination, this is more support for the previous conjecture.

301 - 317	Akvovsh	Was so vain that he personally marched an army north through countless nations without military success and founded the colony of Akvovsh just south of the border with the orcish regions in 317. He never returned from the expedition.
317 - 331	Asharash	Was left as regent king by Akvovsh, was coronated as king upon the failure of Akvovsh to return from his expedition.
331 - 345	Avarissosh	Was king during the Fenosi Conquest of the southeastern and northwestern sections of the Vulddeshaan Empire.
345 - 367	Akranash	Was king during the Fenosi conquest of the northeastern Vulddeshaan Empire frontier.
367 - 398	Avvarish	Was defeated by the Fenosi Empire at the First Battle of Bindi Coast.
398 - 400	Avethesh	Was the last king of the Vulddeshaan Empire, was completely overthrown by the Fenosi Empire in 400.

-75	Helana	It is not known when she succeeded her father, Fenri. First Empress of the Fenosi Empire.
75 - 136	Uonarao	Founded the city of Laned on the Eastern Continent in 98.
136 - 163	Benvon	Lost the Eastern Continent settlement, Laned, to the Vuddeshaan Empire in 152.

165 - 285	Reltin I	Founded the Reltrik Dynasty. Experimented in the art of necromancy to fuel his body with the souls of fallen enemies to extend his life. Killed at the siege of Tam.
285 - 286	Zen	Assassinated by the Tammian Resistance.
286 - 296	Ren	Built the cities of Zetren, Wetren, Vetren, Jena, and Defret. All of which would eventually become the Ren City-States.

	407 - 453	The Fenosi War of Succession. Derit v.s Huk v.s Len v.s Poll v.s Vern v.s Fen v.s Heliani. Huk, Poll, Vern, and Derit were all killed in the Second Battle of Bindi Coast in 419. Len, Fen, and Heliani fought with limited rule over regions of the Fenosi Empire until the year 453.
453 - 786	Heliani	Fell deep into necromancy and used dark blood magic to rule for 333 years. Saw the rise and fall of the elven settlement of Denadarm, the only fully elvish settlement ever established outside of the plain of Andromeda.
786 - 1320	Delina	Thought by modern scholars to only be Heliani controlling the body of her youngest daughter who she named heir just before she died. Possibly extending Haliani's rule to 867 years.
1320 - 1340	Varlirna	Thought to be under the same spell as Delina, extending Heliani's rule to 887 years. Killed by the great hero, Fengo the Great, a long estranged descendent of Fengo, founder of the Fenosi Empire.

1340 - 1403	Fengo the Great / Fengo II	Took the name Fengo II to honor his ancient ancestor. Is confirmed through many historical family records to be the distant descendant of Fengo I.

1523 - 1600	Frent I	Extended the power of the Fenosi people by allowing them to elect an advisory council that would advise the emperor on civil matters. Although the emperor still had absolute rule over the entire empire.

	1979 - 2001	Provincial Governors attempted to keep the Fenosi Empire together through treaties, but they were eventually overrun by bandits and nomads on the empire's borders and many were killed in battle leaving only Jarik to rule the entire Empire.

	2001 - 2007	The Jarikian Dynasty is very controversial among current scholars and philosophers as it was only ever meant to be a transitional period until a true heir to the throne could be found.

2011 - 2051	Opentar	Fulfilled his "dynasties" purpose and abdicated to Reld I, a confirmed descendent of Reltin I.

	2400 - 2421	The Helana Dynasty was instituted by the new senate and was named such as to give it credibility as many still respected the first empress, Helana.
2421 - 2423	Fengrono II	Usurped his father, Helani I and took power for himself. Sired three daughters: Helani II, Helani III, and Helani IV. Froze their souls and their bodies so he could control them later after his death.

3033 - 3076	Worno I	Deposed Qirna in 3033 and split the Mastakor Empire from the Qorica Empire.
3076 - 3089	Worno II	
3089 - 3105	Waqamai	Defended against Qorano III in the second siege of Megakinx. Killed in battle during the final sally forth from the city.
3105 - 3124	Mandrel I	
3124 - 3172	Mandrel II	
3172 - 3195	Mandrel III	
3195 - 3207	Bentin	Lost the city of Megakinx to rebels in 3206. Died of an unknown disease in 3207.
