The Overview tab tells you which class is assigned to which station. It also includes some information about past volunteers who are still at the school, in case you want to reach out for help.

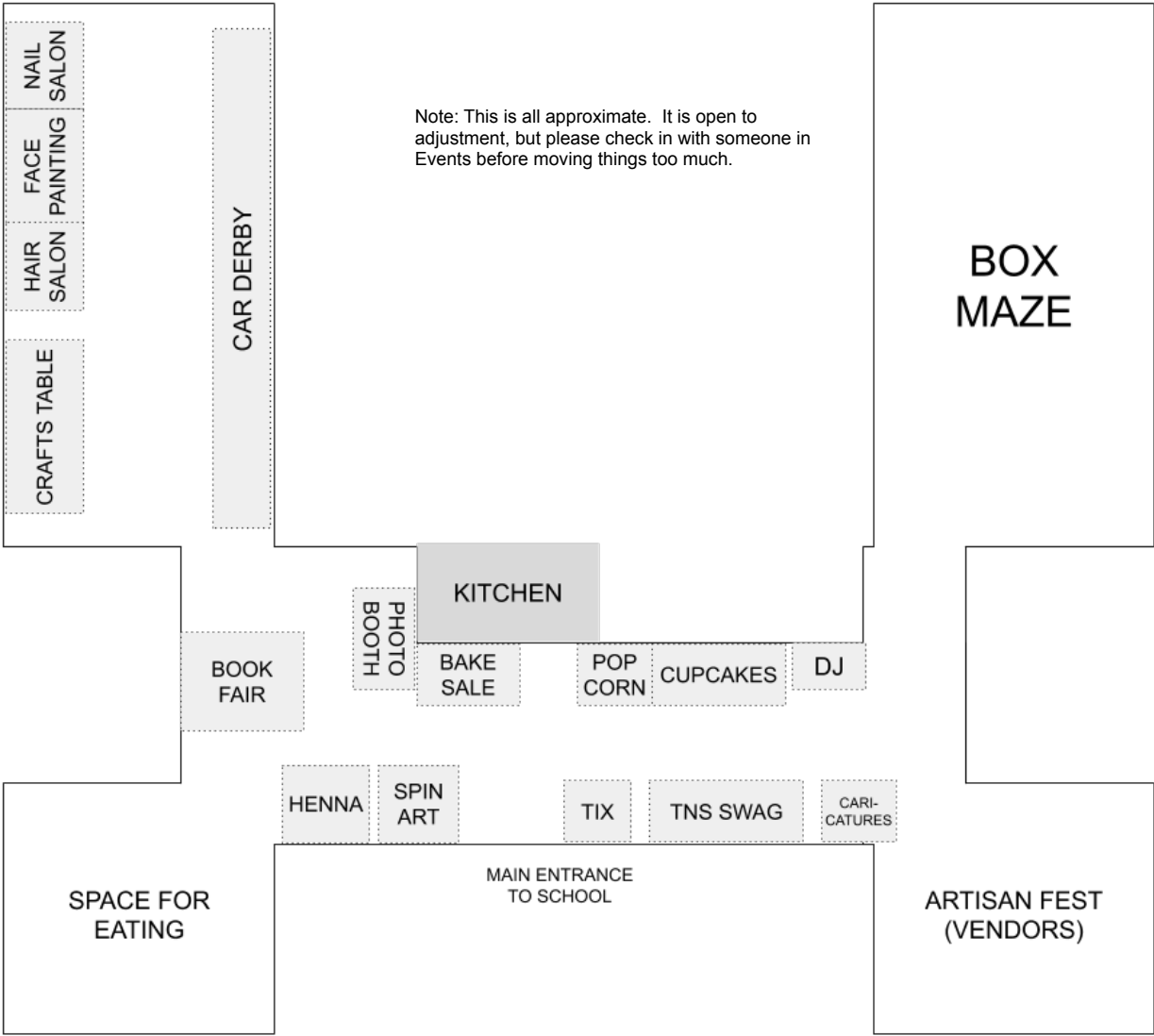
Each station has a tab with more information, including volunteer slots for signing up. Note: the sign-up slots are just a guess. You will be the expert of your station, so adjust as necessary.

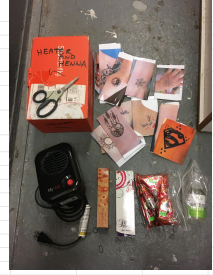

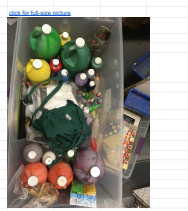

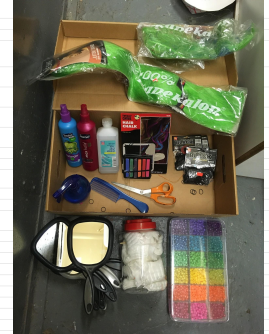

**Payment Overview**

Most of the payment at holiday fair is via activity bracelets. Each bracelet has a list of numbers (1-10 or 1-20). We sell them for cash/credit at the front entrance, and then people at the stations use a marker to cross off numbers on the bracelet to "charge" people for their station. Exceptions to this are Artisan Fest vendors, who handle all of their own payment. Also, TNS Swag and Caricature Station take payment via card swipe. Finally, we do have tickets on hand as a stop-gap measure, at a charge of \$1 each, but we should stay away from using these in general.
