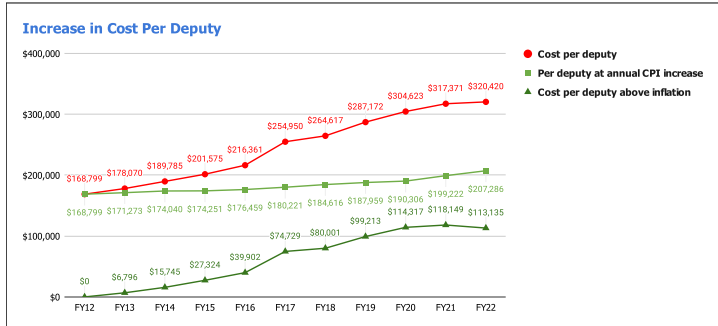

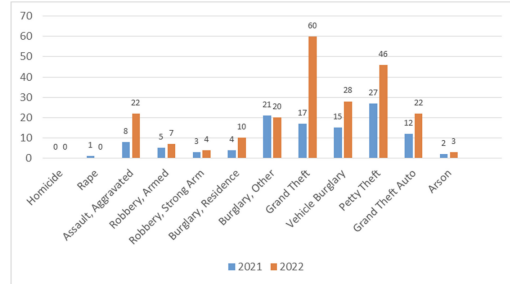

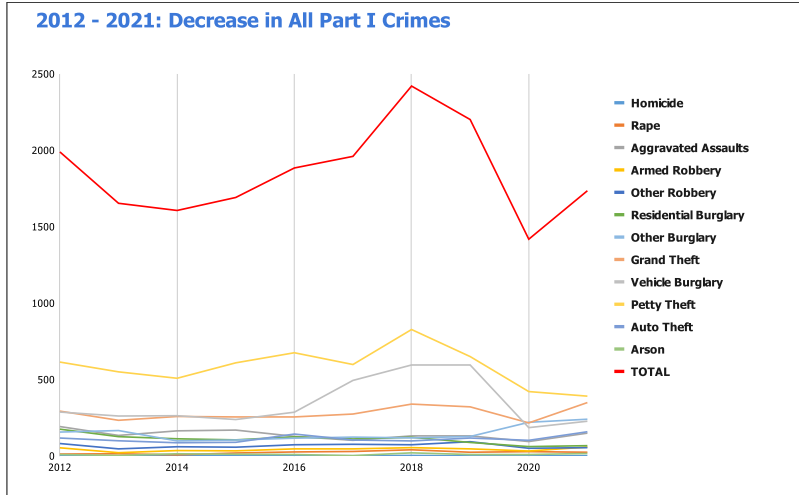
West Hollywood - Whole City

2012 - 2021: Decrease in All Part I Crimes

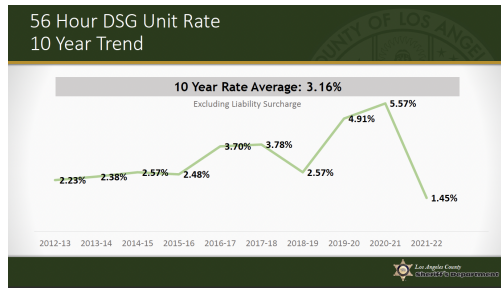


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LASD COST RATE OF CHANGE TRENDS
