For items with multiple responses, all possible responses are listed and only those that align with best practice are marked with an asterisk (*). For items without a clearly defined best practice, a dash (-) is used.
- 2) The "District Response" provides data by school level if at least one school in your district responded to a given item, whereas the "Regional Response" and "State Response" are provided by school level if there are responses from five or more schools, respectively. The sample size for each item may vary, depending on which items were displayed or aligned. If there is insufficient data, a dash (-) is used.
- 3) For "single choice" items, the total percentage of schools that gave the best practice response is listed.
- 4) For multiple choice items, the total percentage of schools that gave each possible response option is listed.
- 5) For items where a number has been entered for the response, the average is reported.
