Filter of Lean	Level 1: Beginner - Initial Exploration	Level 2: Intermediate - Practical Application	Level 3: Advanced - Optimization and Sustainability
1. Identification of Waste (Muda)	Identify obvious wastes in your process and eliminate or reduce them.	Simplify your internal processes or resources ().	Identify and eliminate resource wastage, for example, for all your DAO's subscriptions ().
2. Value Creation	Identify the value your Web3 project provides and to whom.	Provide the development of features based on user demand ().	Redefine the value proposition your project to better address user needs ().
3. Value Stream	Create a basic value stream map of your project's current state.	Map current workflows to identify unnecessary steps ().	Optimize the value stream to enhance flow and reduce lead time.
4. Pull System	Identify areas where a pull system could be implemented.	Implement a mechanism to track user demand and launch new features accordingly ().	Implement demand-based planning to efficiently manage resources ().
5. Continuous Improvement (Kaizen)	Encourage feedback and make small improvements.	Encourage continuous innovation by organizing brainstorming sessions ().	Foster a culture of continuous improvement by regularly testing new ideas to new technologies and methodologies ().
