さん	さん	Sann	씨	Mr. / Ms.	Use <b>さん</b> in a formal situation or with someone you first meet. <b>さん</b> is almost the same as Korean <b>씨</b> .
君	くん	Kunn	-	-	Use <b>くん</b> in a formal situation or with someone in the same social rank.
ちゃん	ちゃん	Chann	-	-	Use <b>ちゃん</b> in a casual situation or with someone you feel close.
御中	おんちゆう	Onn-chuu	-	Company	Use <b>御中</b> when you address the company name in formal writing.
殿	どの	Do-no	-	Sir / Madar	Classic title once used for lords.
<b>肩書き</b>	かたがき	Kata-gaki	-	Name title	Japanese people add <b>肩書き</b> (katagaki) after a person's name. <b>肩書き</b> indicates the person's status in the community.
会長	かいちょう	Kai-chou	회장	Chairman	-
社長	しゃちょう	Sha-chou	사장	President	-
部長	ぶちょう	Bu-chou	부장	Manager	In Japanese corporate practice, the hierarchy is <b>部長 &gt; 課長 &gt; 係長</b>
