NOTES

- Up to 90 transfer cr accepted, including no more than 75 from 2-year institutions; min. transfer GPA is 2.0.
- Course grade must be C or higher. Course number must be 100 level or higher.
- Students must earn min. of 33 total credits in gen ed. For associate degree holders, all gen ed courses are counted toward the 42cr requirement, including those taken in excess of associate degree requirements. Gen ed courses that do not have a single slash through the CRS column must be taken.
- Min. GCU graduation GPA 2.0 overall, 2.5 major. Min. credits for bachelor's degree: 120. At least 30cr must be earned at GCU.

◊ Transfer students must complete a minimum of 21 credits in the Psychology program at GCU, including one of the capstone courses.
