The resort was opened in 1931 to Ed & Art Nunstedt (father and son). The name Chik-Wauk was most likely created by Ed & Art Nunstedt, thinking it was a derivation of an Ojibwe word meaning white pine. The Ojibwe spelling of white pine is zhingwaak, or shingwaak (a pine or white pine). Chik-Wauk Museum & Nature Center presents the cultural and natural history of the Gunflint Trail region. Chik-Wauk Museum & Nature Center is a partnership of The Gunflint Trail Historical Society & USDA Forest Service Superior National Forest, Gunflint Ranger District. The Chik-Wauk Lodge building was listed on the National Registry of Historic Places in 2007.
