

CHPA MOST IMPROVED PLAYERS OF THE YEAR RULES

1). The Most Improved Player of the Year Award was started by our CHPA Officers in 1992.

Rules:

Selection will be made to the four groups--Men, Women, Elder's, Junior's.

The award is based on the highest ringer percentage gained starting from the previous year December 31st. and ending in the current December 31st.

The Men, Women and Elders must have pitched in 3 tournaments in the previous year and the current year for this award.

Juniors are only required to pitched in 2 tournaments in the previous year and the current year for this award.

The State Statistician will determine the winner.

The pitcher receiving the highest ringer percentage gained will receive the award.

The Most Improved Award winner will be announced at the following State Banquet and will receive a plaque.

CHPA will fund trophy cost.
